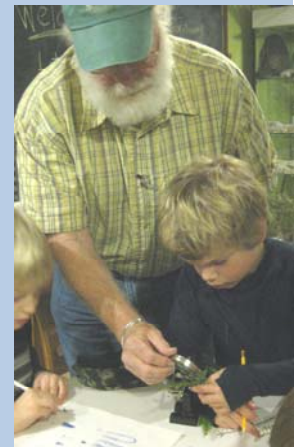
NATURE CONNECTION & MENTORING INTERNSHIP FAQ'S



Who Should Apply?

We're looking for energetic, positive, creative, curious, hard-working, playful people with a love of nature, learning, and mentoring kids in the natural world. Applicants must be at least 18 years old. Older applicants (career changers, etc.) are welcome too!

What Do Interns Do ? In short - **learn, work & grow.** All interns are trained to serve as staff/mentors on youth programs; take part in frequent naturalist training & tracking programs; and work on personal goals in the areas of Leadership, Nature Connection, & 8Shields Mentoring. All internships are customized.



Where Do Interns Live & Work?

We assist interns in finding affordable, local housing—sometimes there are rooms in the homes of community members, sometimes winter rentals. All programs are within 20 mins. of White Pine.



How Do The Finances Work? All internships are customized internships depending upon applicant experience & skill level. Interns receive a stipend to help offset living costs.
