**Dan Gardoqui** has been practicing & sharing bird language for over 20 years. He founded White Pine Programs and served as science editor for "What the Robin Knows."



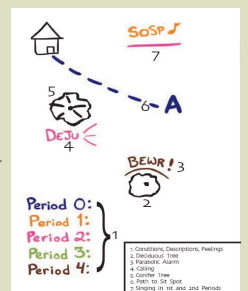
